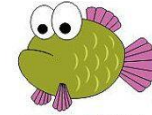




Expressive Arts and Design

During Circle time, we enjoyed sharing with the class the things we had been doing over the half term break.

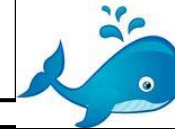
We worked together to create mini-beast homes and water ways using the water run.
