We have been using the 2Simple software to support our Maths and Literacy and to create our own pictures. Some of the children are becoming very good at changing the programme and helping others.

## **Literacy**

*Reading and Writing*

We have again been working on our two syllable words and using our phonic knowledge to read sentences. We also had a go at counting the syllables in our own names.

We listened to the story Elmer and the Hippos. We then put together a jumbled sentence from the story before copying it into our books. We talked about the capital letter at the beginning, finger spaces between each word and a full stop at the end of our sentence. We used our phonic skills to help us read the words in our guided reading books. These are different to the books they bring home and can be of a higher colour band.
