Making Relationships, Self Confidence and Self Awareness and Managing Feelings and Behaviour

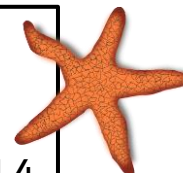
We played the fruit basket game in Circle time and then passed Derek the Donkey around saying the things we like about our school.
