## Personal, Social and Emotional Development

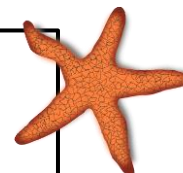
Making Relationships, Self Confidence and Self Awareness and Managing Feelings and Behaviour
