We have been thinking about the way we treat other people, remembering that sometimes the things we do can upset others.

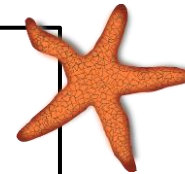
We have been trying really hard to remember our manners, particularly please and thank you.
