*Making Relationships, Self Confidence and Self Awareness and Managing Feelings and Behaviour*

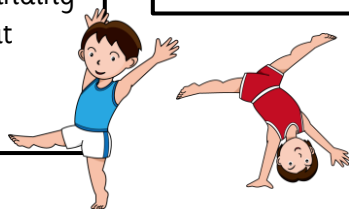
We enjoyed Circle Time this week when we passed Derek the donkey round the circle, taking it in turns to talk about our weekend. We also passed on a smile.
