Literacy



We have continued to learn to tell the story of The 3 Little Pigs.

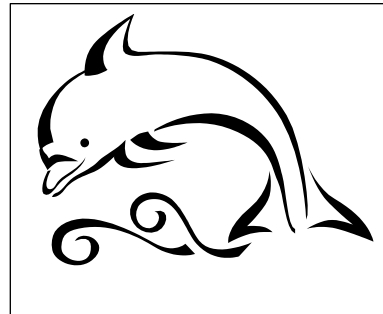
Maths
