Phonics

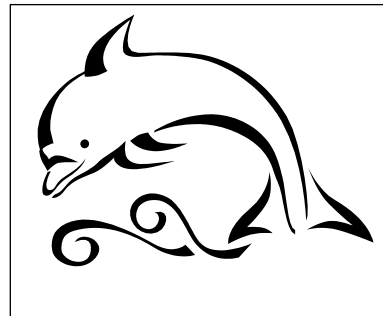
We revised the sounds 'ay', 'ue' and 'ir' and wrote some sentences that included these sounds.
