In the afternoon we went over to the church for our first Nativity rehearsal.

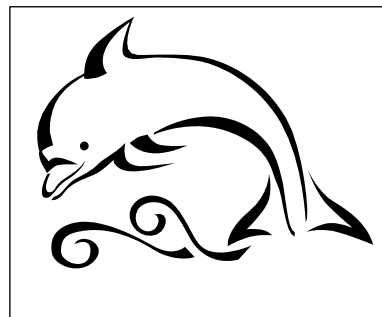


Wednesday
