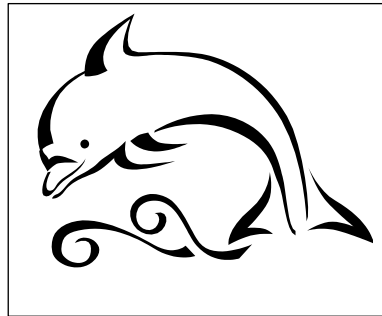
Music
