In multi-skills we worked on our dribbling skills with a hockey stick.

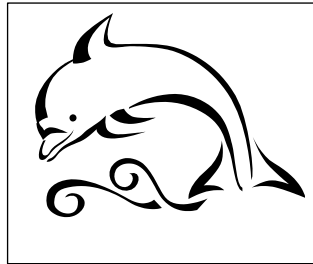
Music
