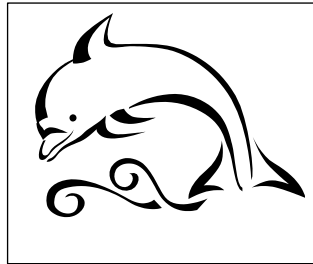
Music
