P.E

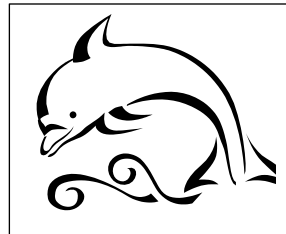
In multiskills we have started to play basketball. We practiced bouncing the ball with one and two hands and bouncing it to a partner.
