Music

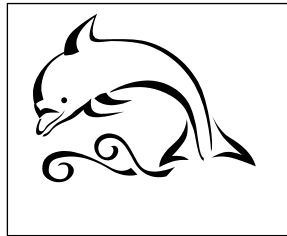
We have been learning more call and response songs and we had great fun using djembes for the first time!
