We have learnt a welcome song called 'I'm so excited' from Uganda which we sing beautifully.

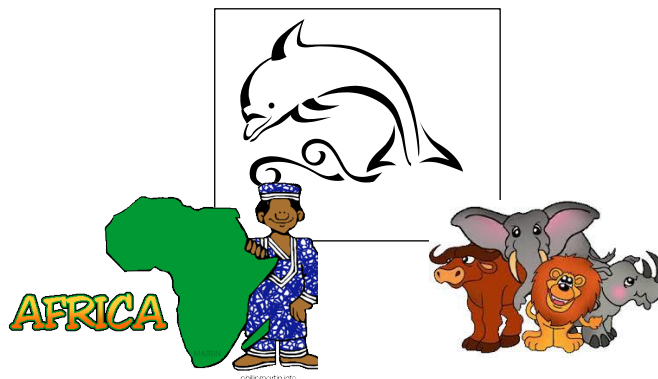
