### Science

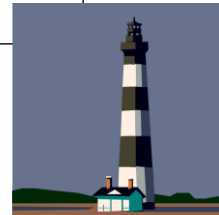
We started to learn about plants. We learnt about the different parts of a plant and that we eat the roots, stem, leaves or flowers of different plants.
