Spring term

English - Over the term, we will be developing our writing skills, focusing closely on writing posters, recounts, poems and narratives. Some of our books include 'Toys in Space' and 'Last Stop on Market street'.

Maths - We will be continuing our coverage of the National Curriculum, looking at areas such as addition and subtraction, fractions, measurement and multiplication and division.

Science - In the first half of the Spring term, we will be looking closely at seasonal changes and understanding changes that happen over time. After half term, we will be exploring pushes and pulls, investigating how objects move and how pushing and pulling can change an object's shape.

Geography - In our Geography lessons, we will be exploring where the UK is in the world and where Hambledon is in the UK. We will then be building on our knowledge of human and physical features, thinking about how we use our local area and what we like/don't like about it.

Art - We will be using a range of materials and techniques to design and create a felt leaf. Before creating our finished products, we will be developing a variety of skills such as observational drawings, sewing and other methods of joining.

D&T - After half term, we will be looking at levers and sliders, identifying how these work and using these skills to create our own moving pictures.

Computing - Using our developing Computing skills, we will explore digital painting by creating art work using Paint and using algorithms to make a robot move.

PSHE themes - Keeping ourselves safe and being my best self.

PE - We will be doing target games and dance during the first half of the term and gymnastics and Invasion games after half term.

RE themes - We are focussing on persuasion, focusing on the reasons why people did what Jesus asked them, and Easter.
