Would they have survived the fire?

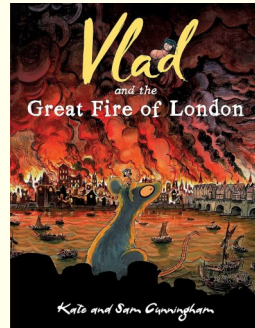
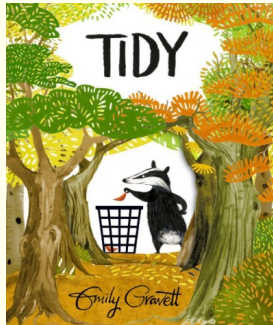
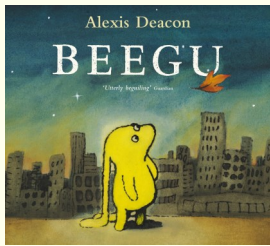

Autumn term

English - Over the term, we will be using stories to develop our writing skills, focussing closely on writing and joining sentences. We will be using these skills in many pieces of writing, such as narratives, diary entries and poetry.



Maths - We will be continuing our coverage of the National Curriculum, looking at areas such as place value, addition and subtraction, multiplication and division and measurement.

Science - This term we will be learning about materials and their properties. We will sort materials into different groups and perform some simple investigations.

Geography - In our Geography lessons, we will be exploring where the UK is in the world and where Hambledon is in the UK. We will be building our knowledge of what a map is and how to use one.

D&T - In the second half term, we will be developing our understanding of structures and joins, learning various skills before creating our own Tudor style houses.

Art - We will be developing our understanding of colour, looking at how to mix paints to make different colours and shades. We will be learning about Andy Goldsworthy and creating a piece of artwork based on his style.

History - Throughout this topic, we will be learning about the Great Fire of London - finding out how and where it started, how quickly it spread and the damage it caused. We will be learning about key individuals and we will think about the differences if the fire were to happen today.

Computing - Using our developing Computing skills, we will be creating and modifying digital images to create our own digital artwork. We will also be creating simple animations to recount the events of the Great Fire of London.

PSHE themes - Me and my relationships and valuing difference

PE - We will be doing fundamental and ball skills followed by dance and invasion games.

RE themes - We are focussing on celebration, looking closely at Harvest.
