We will be learning about seasonal changes. We will be looking at what happens to the plants and trees around our school during the year and investigating weather patterns.



PE

We will be practicing our bat and ball skills. We will be learning to pass a ball to a partner and hit a target. We will use these skills to play indoor cricket.

Maths

We will be working with 2D and 3D shapes. We will use them to make patterns and pictures and to sort in to charts and Venn diagrams. We will also use words such as corners and edges to describe them.

We will be continuing to develop our sense of number and counting skills. We will be starting to learn about fractions and will be folding and colouring halves and quarters of shapes to help us. We will be partitioning 6, 7 and 10 and record into addition sentences and we will start to think about the corresponding subtraction facts. We will be adding a pair of numbers by putting the largest number first.

Geography

We will be learning all about the Arctic and Antarctic. We will be using a globe and maps to locate the North and South Pole and learning about the features of these areas. We will compare the lifestyle of an inuit to the lifestyle of people living in the UK and learn what animals live in these regions.



Literacy

We will be writing wintery poems. We will be learning to use exciting words to describe the weather and how to use similes and alliteration in our sentences.

We will be learning about Arctic and Antarctic animals and creating our own fact books about them. We will use the internet, books and film to research the animals.

We will be thinking about ways of getting on with each other rather than falling out. We will be thinking about the qualities of a good friend and what we can do when things don't our way.
