Literacy

Maths

In maths we will be learning about measurements. We will be thinking hard about how to measure accurately and also how to estimate. We will be using non-standard units to measure such as cubes. We will also be continuing our learning on subtracting and will extend this to think about finding the difference between 2 numbers. We will also be exploring capacity of objects, measuring with water and rice. We will be using the information to make graphs such as block graphs and pictograms.
