### Literacy

We began our new Literacy module on play scripts this week. On Tuesday, we read and performed a play, identifying the key features of this genre. On Wednesday, we have started to read our play for the end of term performance called "Ruthless Romans". The children auditioned for the parts they were interested in. On Friday, we spent more time reading the stage directions of our play and began reading our parts together. On Thursday, we read a scene from a play and worked together to write our own scene, we had to ensure we included all the key features of a play. In our grammar lessons we have learnt about using an apostrophe to show possession.

### DT

In DT this week, we evaluated our Roman chariots. We were all really pleased with our finished models!

### Maths

In Maths on Monday and Tuesday, we explored capacity. We estimated the capacity of various different containers and then measured them in millilitres and litres with increasing accuracy. On Thursday, we completed an investigation linked to money we had to decide on which coins to use in order to reach our given total. On Friday, we ended the week with a range of 2 step problems to solve involving money and calculating change.

### History

We completed our History unit on the Romans this week by thinking about the importance of the legacy that they left in Britain.

### Science

In Science, we have discussed the term 'electrical conductor'. We have tested a range of different materials within our electrical circuit to see if the bulb still lights up.
