Literacy

In Literacy this week, we began our new module on Historical Stories. On Monday, we explored a range of stories and had to predict which historical period they came from. In Tuesday's lesson, we read the opening of 'The Gladiators from Capua' and identified the vocabulary which informed us that this story was set in Roman times. On Wednesday, we read the 'The Battle of Britain' using a story map. We boxed up the story into 4 paragraphs. On Thursday we wrote our own opening paragraph in the role of a Roman Soldier using a range of adjectives to describe the setting and our feelings as we headed to battle. On Friday, we continued our version of the story

DT

In DT this week, we made the axle and wheels for our chariot and attached them to our chassis.

Maths

Our Maths lessons this week focussed on multiplication and division. On Monday and Tuesday, we solved multiplication calculations and word problems. For the rest of the week, we revisited 'chunking' in division using our knowledge of times tables. We solved a range of calculations using this method.

PE

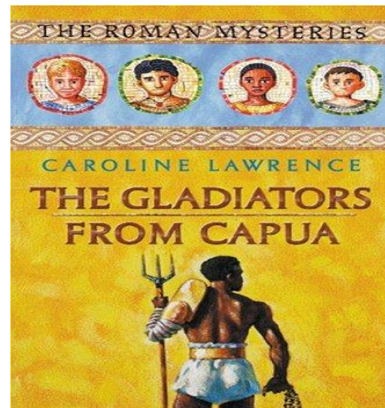
In Tennis, we focussed on our ball control. In Cricket, we were batting and bowling to one another.

RE

In RE, this week we continued our unit on temptation by reading the story of 'Moses and the Golden Calf'. We then used drama and role play to retell this story.



Science

In Science, we created a range of different circuits using a variety of resources such as buzzers, switches and motors. We drew each circuit using symbols and made a prediction to whether we felt the bulb would light.

History

Using books and laptops we researched a particular aspect of Roman Life. We presented this as an information page.

Music

In Music, we learnt to sing in unison to a Roman song. We revised the notation for the Miniature March and also practised a dance for Ceilidh.
