## **Literacy**

On Wednesday, we started to read the Pie Corbett story 'Why the sky is so high'. We read the story map in pairs in order to help us remember the plot. We also added actions to the story in preparation for the Pie Corbett assembly. In grammar, we learnt the importance of imperative verbs.

Lastly, we joined our pieces of wood together to make a rectangle and secured each corner with card triangles.
