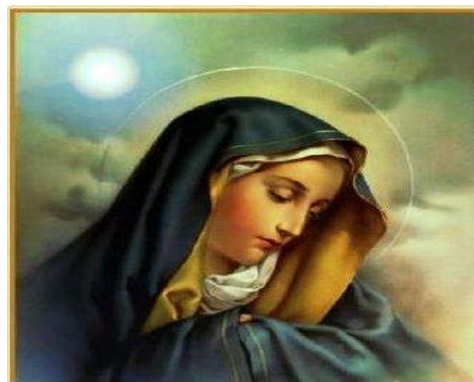
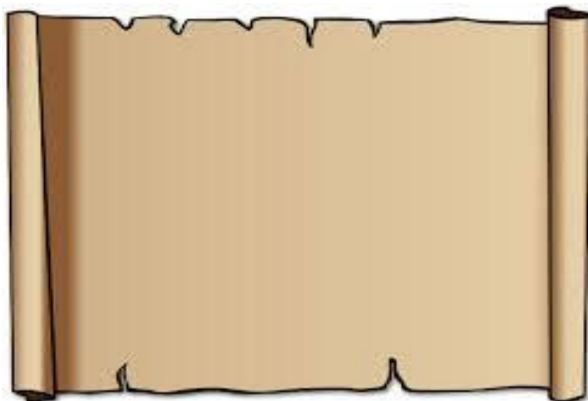
Maths

Some of use solved a range of word problems involving division with reminders.
