### Literacy

This week in Literacy, we began learning 'The Pied Piper of Hamelin' ready for our story telling assembly next Friday. We used a story map to retell the folktale to a partner on Tuesday. We have used the story map to orally rehearse the story in pairs. We have also created our own version of a story map in order to practise our retelling. As a class we have added actions to our performance. We enjoyed our first rehearsal to the visitors during Open Morning.

### Maths

This week in Maths, we have looked at the different types and sizes of angles. We have learnt their names and identified them in various shapes. In other lessons we continued to practise our times tables and work on an investigation using our addition skills.

### PSHE

As part of our Rights and Responsibilities unit we have discussed ways in which to improve our school.

### Art

In Art this week, we removed the masking tape from our textiles piece of work to reveal our finished pattern. Our work had a variety of horizontal, vertical and diagonal lines and a range of different colours.
