Creative Development

As Artists we will be learning how to mix colours, and explore tools for painting such as paint brushes, rollers, sponges and our own hands and feet!
As musicians we will be learning to sing a range of songs and rhymes and will also be investigating dynamics with percussion instruments.
We will be making Autumn collages from natural materials. **What materials can you find in your garden for the collage?**

Communication Language and Literacy

Speaking and listening

We will be talking about ourselves, our likes/dislikes etc.

We will imagine and re-create roles and experiences e.g. in the roleplay area.

Reading

We will be reading fiction and non-fiction books about our senses.

In our Phonics sessions we will be linking sounds and letters and blending them to read words. We will also be learning to recognise alliteration and rhyme.

Writing

We will be learning to give meaning to the marks that we make and write our name and other familiar words. **What letter does your name start with?**



Physical Development

We will be developing our Gymnastic skills, learning to travel around under, over and through balancing and climbing equipment. **What ways do you think you can move your body to make it go faster?**

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will form good relationships with peers and adults and understand what makes a good friend. We will become familiar with the school rules and understand behavioural expectations in school. **Do you know what makes a good friend?**

Knowledge and Understanding of the World

As Scientists we will:

- learn about our senses and will use them to explore the world around us,
- investigate textures and materials,
- find out about the season of Autumn.

As Historians we will think about the past and present in our own lives and will compare what babies do and what we can do now.

We will develop mouse control when using computer programmes.

We will design and make sound makers and toys for babies.

As Geographers we will investigate our school locality and record our journey on a map. **What do you see on your way to school?**



Problem Solving, Reasoning and Numbers

As Mathematicians we will be learning to:

- count a range of objects correctly
- recognise numbers to 10 and beyond
- represent numbers in a variety of ways i.e. marks on paper, pictures and by writing numbers
- recognise 2D shapes, and describe their properties, and will be hunting for shapes in our school
- sort objects by colour/ shape etc.

We will also be singing a range of number rhymes. **How many nursery rhymes can you already sing?**
