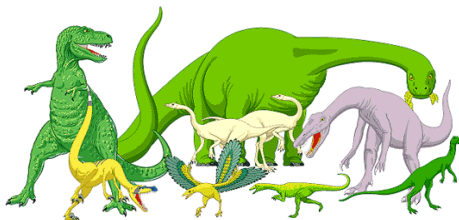


PE

During Multi-skills on a *Thursday*, this half term we will be focusing on games. As scientists we will continue our study of our garden. We will also be finding out and learning about Plants.

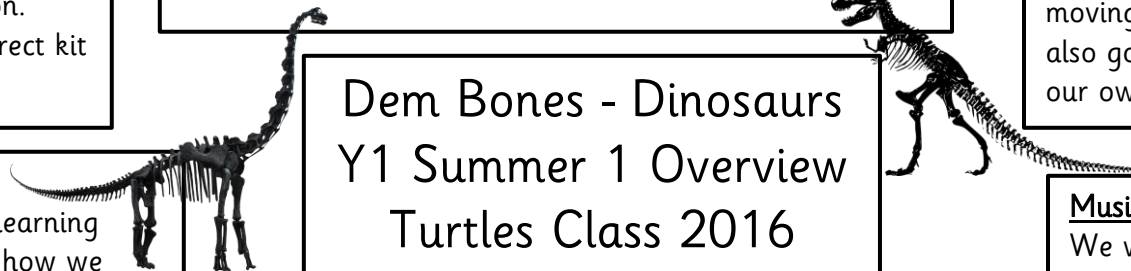
Art / Design Technology

Topic – History

During our Dinosaur topic we will be learning about the different types of dinosaur, how we know about them and what clues they left behind to help us find out. We will be learning about the Palaeontologist Mary Anning who discovered dinosaur fossils on the Isle of Wight.



Computing

The children will continue to use the laptops and class computers to support and enrich their learning. They will have a go at using the Internet to help research different dinosaurs. They will also look at common uses of technology beyond school.

English

We will start this half term by writing about our Easter holiday. The children will write a sentence about three things they did and then they will join these three things together as a mini recount. We will be listening to a variety of traditional tales and comparing them to Philippa Leather's Black Rabbit. The children will also be learning how to write a letter and a postcard, thinking about how they construct their sentences and then also using poetry to help them write their own poem.

Music

We will continue our Listen to me programme with Mrs Harmer and also learning some songs and rhymes about dinosaurs.

PSHE / RE

During RE we will be learning about the concept of Special and in particular, special clothes. During PSHE we will be focusing on relationships.
