Development

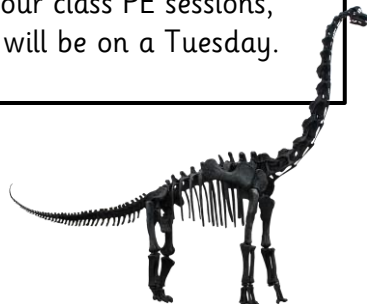
Making Relationships, Self Confidence and Self Awareness and Managing Feelings and Behaviour

Understanding The World

People and Communities, The World, Technology

As Scientists we will be learning about plants and observing the changes in our garden.

We will continue to use our class computers, Interactive White-board, and Bee-bots to enhance our learning. Our topic this half term is Dem Bones - Dinosaurs. We will be learning about the different dinosaurs whilst also finding out about the Palaeontologist Mary Anning. During RE we will be focussing on the idea of 'special' and in particular, learning about special clothes.
