

## PE

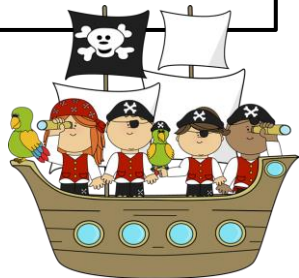
