The children learnt about meat eating dinosaur. They then used books to help them to draw one.

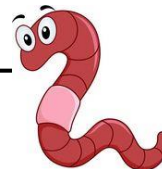
They also learnt that Sauropods were some of the biggest dinosaurs to roam the earth.
