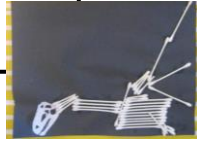


## Expressive Arts and Design

## Mathematics

Numbers and Shape, Space & Measure

They have also been halving shapes that they made from shapes and sharing numbers of objects equally between 2.

## Understanding The World

Continuing our dinosaur topic, the children learnt about the famous fossil hunter Mary Anning from Lyme Regis. Mary found the first complete Ichthyosaurus fossil. The children learnt how fossils are created and some of them had a go at making their own dinosaur skeletons from art straws stuck onto black paper.

The children have enjoyed watching Andy's Prehistoric Adventures to help them develop their understanding of dinosaurs.

The children learnt about the life cycle of a butterfly during science.



## Literacy
