Mathematics

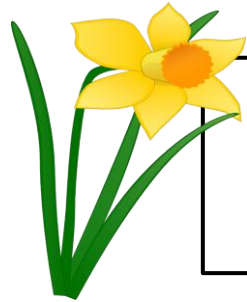
Maths this week has focused on place value, learning about the value of 10 and 1. The children have been generating sums using place value cards and recording them. $56=50+6$, $89=80+9$.
