PSHE/RE

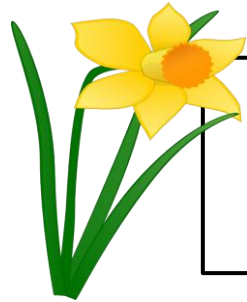
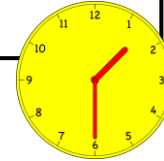
During RE we have been learning about the Easter story and sequencing events from the story.
