Exploring and using media and materials, Being imaginative

Mathematics

Numbers and Shape, Space & Measure

We have been counting to 100 and counting in 10's with the Y1 children.

We had to estimate how many objects were in a bag and say which bag we thought had the most objects in it. We then counted out the objects to see if we were right. I then put out 10 objects in different ways and the children had to say if there was more or less or still 10. They learnt that just because the group looks different it doesn't necessarily mean the number of objects has changed.

Physical Development

During gym this week we were balancing on 1, 2 & 3 parts of the body in a high balance and a low balance and travelling along, over, under and around low apparatus.
