



Art / Design Technology

We have started making 'stained glass' turtles. We will be joining their flippers and heads on using split pins so that they can move.

We have looked carefully at each other and talked about eye and hair colour. We then used this information to draw self-portraits.

Mathematics

We have practised writing our numbers 1-10. The children each used a numberline to check that they had written them correctly and then corrected any that were the wrong way round.

We have been matching the correct numbers to amounts of objects and then showing our answers practically and in our maths books.

Topic – History

We have talked a little bit out our families and have shared a couple of stories about the Large family by Jill Murphy and thought about how some of the things that happen in the stories might happen in our own families. We created our topic book covers.

Computing

Science

We learnt to use the connective and when writing sentences.

This week all of the children have been involved with guided and quiet reading. We will continue to change our home reading books three times a week.
