

## Expressive Arts and Design

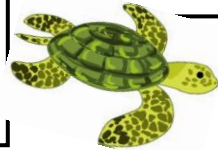
Exploring and using media and materials, Being imaginative

We really enjoyed sharing each other's baby photos and trying to guess who they all were. They also had fun trying to guess some who some of the staff baby pictures belonged to.

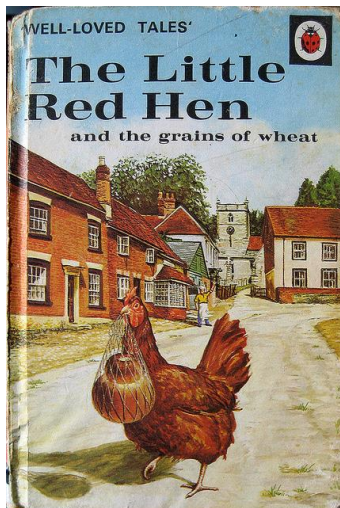


## Literacy
