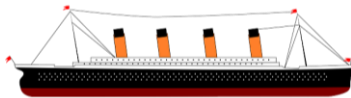


English

This week we have looked at the language used in the story 'How the World was Made' and we tried to improve it by using adventurous adjectives to describe the mountains, stars, rivers and other nouns mentioned in the story. We have also changed the opening paragraph of the story by adding more description.



We have continued our research in to the Titanic. This week we have answered questions by looking at the timeline of events and reading fact cards. We have also listened to a first-hand account of a survivor from the Titanic disaster and wrote down key points.

This week we have looked at the artist Rothko. We have talked about secondary colours and created our own colour field paintings using our own mixed colours in the style of Rothko.

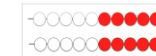


Maths

We have continued to count in steps of 2, 3, 5 and 10 this week. At the beginning of the week we worked hard at putting these counting skills into practise when we were solving some problems



We had another go at adding a single-digit number to a two-digit number by bridging ten. We are able to use 100 squares and beaded number string and number lines to help us.



Science

In Science this week we have continued to think about life cycles. We studied the life cycle of the frog in detail. We made small lift up flap books about the eight stages of a frog's life cycle but we had to be very careful we got them in the correct order.
