eg: double 13

double 10 = 20

double 3 = 6

20 + 6 = 26

We have been continuing our practice with the 'er' suffix. We have looked for words that have a 'y' at the end so that we have to "drop the y and add an 'i' and then er.

eg: funny - funnier
