This week we listened to some castle music and tried hard to identify the instruments that were playing. We then learnt a partner dance.

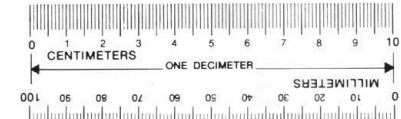
### R.E
