

AUTUMN 1 – G'DAY SPORT!

Literacy

Our Literacy this half term will link to our 'Gday Sport!' topic. In our first module on riddles, the children will be writing about Australian animals using a range of descriptive language. Our non-fiction unit on information texts will provide children with opportunities to read and discuss a range of information texts about Australia, before researching and writing their own. In our module on cultural tales, the children will be exploring aboriginal stories.

Maths

In Maths this half term, we will cover a range of modules, beginning with written addition and subtraction methods. Our unit on statistics will link to our ICT lessons. We will also be solving problems involving a range of measurements.

Music

This term, Mrs Harmer will be teaching the children how to play the ukulele.



Geography

Geography will be our lead subject this half term as we explore amazing Australia! During this topic, we will explore the location of Australia in the world, and familiarise ourselves with its landscape features and climate.

Art

In Art, we will be designing and creating an imaginary Australian animal from clay.

DT

In our DT lessons, we will be using card levers and pivots to form a linkage mechanism.

PSHCE

This half term, the children will be learning to identify positive things about themselves and their achievements. School Council elections will also take place.

PE

The children will be taught tag rugby by the coach in multi-skills this half term. They will also begin their swimming lessons at Waterlooville swimming pool.

Science

This half term, we will be learning about our body. Our focus will be the importance of diet and how we can stay healthy in order to develop and grow. We will also learn about the skeleton and how muscles work to move different parts of the body.

ICT

This half term, our ICT and Maths lessons will link with each other. We will be collecting a range of data and then creating various graphs to present our results.
