

SHARKS' CURRICULUM OVERVIEW

SUMMER 1 - SIN DEX

Literacy

Our Literacy this half term, will link to our History topic. In our module on Roman mythology, we will be reading a range of Roman myths and identifying the key features of this genre. This will then lead to us writing myths of our own. In our unit on historical stories, we will be exploring a variety of stories set in Roman times. Later in the half term, we will be writing haiku and tanka poems. Our Spelling lessons this half term will focus on adding suffixes to root words.

Maths

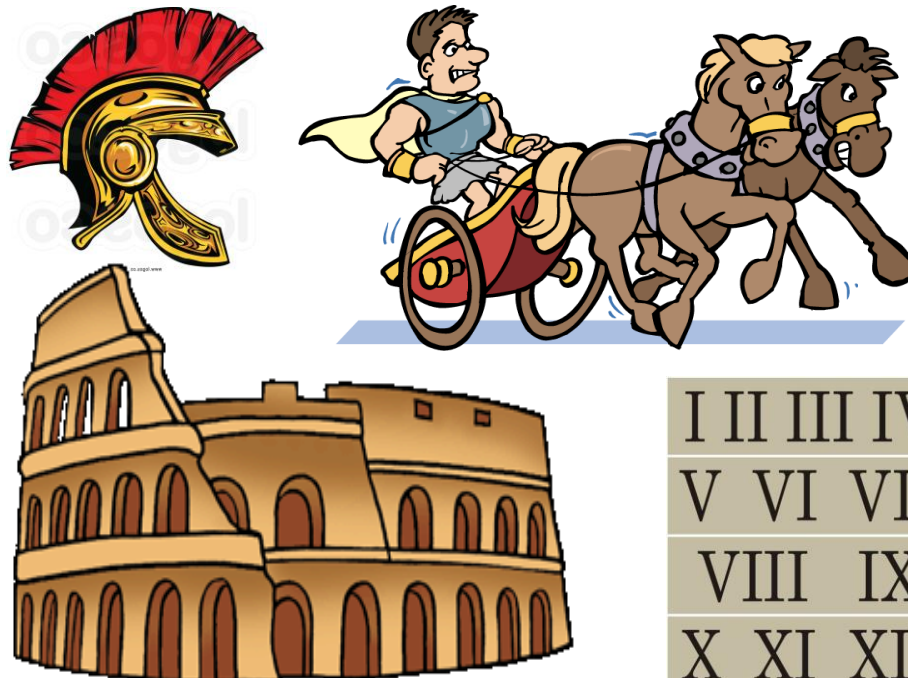
In Maths this half term, we will be practising using formal written methods for addition and subtraction, and multiplying and dividing two and three digit numbers by a single digit. In our measures lessons, we will use a range of measures to estimate and record capacity. In our unit on statistics, we will be interpreting and presenting data using bar charts, pictograms and tables. Linking to our History topic, we will also explore Roman numerals.

DT

We will be designing and creating Roman chariots in DT this half term. Using wood, we will first make the chassis of our chariot, before adding the axles and wheels.

Music

In our weekly Music lessons with Miss Wilson from Hampshire Music Service, we will be learning to play samba instruments.



History

History will be our lead subject this half term as we explore the Romans in our 'Sin Dex' topic (*left, right* – the sound of the Roman army on the move!) We will be exploring what life was like in Britain during Roman times, and the impact that the Roman invasion had on our country. As part of our topic, we will be visiting 'Butser Ancient Farm' to experience what life was like in Britain for the Celts before the Romans invaded.

Science

In Science, we will be investigating rocks and soils. We will be exploring the different kinds used in our local environment, including those in buildings and gravestones.

Art

We will be exploring and creating Roman mosaics in our Art lessons.

PE

In PE, our focus will be cricket. We will also start a gymnastics module. In May, we will be Maypole dancing!
