### Literacy

In Literacy this week, we began our new module on Roman myths. On Monday, we explored the story of 'Romulus and Remus' which explained how the city of Rome was founded. On Wednesday, we read the story of 'The Oak and the Linden Tree.' We wrote the story from the point of view of one of the main characters ensuring we included the features of a myth. On Thursday, we read the story of Oedipus and the Sphinx. We answered key questions relating to the text. In SPAG, we are working on identifying a phrase and a clause.

### Art

In Art this week, we learnt about Roman mosaics. We then designed and created our own individual mosaic using paper tiles.

### Maths

In Maths this week, we focussed on addition and subtraction. On Monday, we were given a range of addition and subtraction calculations and had to sort these into those we could do and those we couldn't, explaining our reasoning. On Wednesday, we worked on the calculations that we found more challenging in the previous lesson. On Thursday, we were introduced to a formal method of addition by partitioning the numbers before completing the calculation.

### Music

On Monday afternoon, we began our Samba lessons with Miss Wilson from Hampshire Music Service.

### History

On Monday, we began our new History topic on the Romans. We explored what life was like for the Celts in Britain before the Romans invaded, and discussed the main reasons for the invasion.



### Science

In Science, we began our new topic on rocks and soils. In our first lesson we learnt about how sedimentary and igneous rocks are formed.

### PE

This week in cricket we were introduced to over arm and under arm bowling techniques. We started with target hoops enabling us to focus on the accuracy of our bowling.
