Literacy

In Literacy this week, we started learning about Kennings, a poem made up of several lines to describe something or someone. On Thursday we began to write our own poems based on our class teacher! Maths

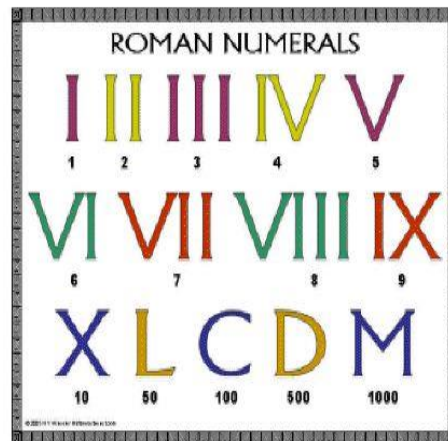
