### Maths

This week in Maths, our focus was weight. We looked at a range of different sized weights to have an understanding of how they felt. We created a list of different fruit that totalled 1kg. On Thursday, we used scales to measure a range of different items. We made a prediction by holding the object and recorded the weight of it to the nearest gram. We created a table for our results.

### Literacy

In Literacy this week, we continued with work on explanation texts. We read a description of a machine called "The Teacher Pleaser". In pairs we drew a picture to match the workings of the machine. We took on the role of salesmen and tried to practise a sales pitch in order to promote the product. In grammar, we worked on quantifiers in a sentence, where quantity is expressed.

### Art

On Tuesday, we created our individual cave paintings which we had designed last week. We used paint and a brush for the majority of our painting. However, for one area, we had to use a twig as a brush and mud, berries, chalk or charcoal for paint.

### History

This week, we concluded our topic on prehistoric Britain. The children really enjoyed our dress up day on Tuesday, and looked absolutely fantastic in their costumes! They particularly enjoyed showing and telling everyone what they had learnt in our class assembly, and sharing a Stonehenge cake with parents whilst looking through their topic books.
