Literacy

This week, we began our new Literacy module on Legends. On Tuesday, we read a range of legends and began to explore the key features of this genre. On Wednesday, we read the legend of George and the Dragon, we identified the characters, setting, creature, the plot and the historical clues. On Thursday, we read a local legend called the 'Legend of the Cockatrice' to improve our understanding of the text we answered questions relating to story.

History

We began our new History unit on Monday in which we will be completing a local study of Hambleton. As a class, we first considered what we knew about Hambleton as a village. We then explored a range of photographs of Hambleton which had been taken throughout the years. We had to identify what each photograph told us about the village, and explain what we would like to find out more about.

Maths

In Maths this week, we began our new unit on addition and subtraction. On Monday, we were given a range of addition and subtraction calculations. We had to decide whether we could answer these calculations and, if we couldn't, explain why. On Tuesday, we focussed on subtraction using a number line. On Wednesday, we identified the different ways we can answer subtraction calculations. On Thursday, some of us completed a range of mathematical riddles in order to complete a route through a maze. Whilst others continued to work on a familiar written method to solve word problems.

Science

This week in Science we worked on our longitudinal study. (an investigation to be monitored throughout the year). This involved setting up an investigation to observe and record the changes in water.



Art

In Art on Tuesday, we collaboratively created a poppy wreath for Remembrance Day next week. We also designed an individual Christmas card.

PE

This week was our first lesson on Tri -golf, we learnt putting control this involved using the putt to guide the ball through a tunnel of cones.
