



Dolphins Topic Overview

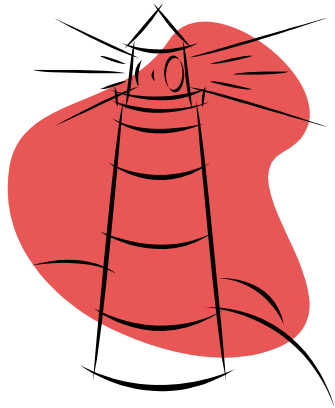
Summer Term 2014



In **History** we will be learning all about Grace Darling. We will be using different sources such as photos, paintings, video, newspapers and the internet to help us answer historical questions. We will be recounting Grace Darling's story in various ways such as diary entries and newspaper headlines.

In **Art and Design** we will be using viewfinders to focus our observation skills on parts of objects. We will be using our imaginations by looking at parts of pictures and thinking what could make up the rest of the picture. We will be using paint to express our ideas.

In **Science** we will be learning about Electricity. We will be identifying items that use electricity and thinking hard about whether they transfer the electricity into heat, light, sound or movement. We will be learning about the dangers of electricity and challenging ourselves to make electrical circuits.

In **Literacy** we will be learning to re-tell stories to an audience. We will be writing our own stories with a seaside setting. We will be reading the Lighthouse Keeper stories. We will be using these stories to help us write in different styles.

In **Music** we will be learning to play the ukulele. We will be learning the parts of the instrument and the names of the notes it can play. We will be playing songs about the sea.

In **P.E** we will be enjoying developing our ball skills during our multi-sports sessions. We will be creating some dances by acting out stories to music.

In **R.E.** we will be learning about special clothes. We will be thinking about why people wear special clothes and how these make them feel or help them to do their job. We will be thinking about the special clothes that a vicar wears.

In **Mathematics** we will be focusing on our number skills. We will be continuing to learn to add and subtract using number lines so that we can show how we solved a problem. We will be learning about place value and splitting numbers into tens and ones. We will be ordering numbers to further develop our sense of place value.
