

STINGRAYS' CURRICULUM OVERVIEW

SPRING 2 - ROUND THE RIVER BEND

Maths

This half term in Maths, we will be focussing on converting a range of different measures. We will be learning about 2D shapes and identifying their lines of symmetry and right angles. We will also continue to develop our written methods for addition and subtraction.

Literacy

In our Literacy modules this half term, we will be exploring adventure stories and shape poetry. Both will link to our rivers topic. In the final week of the half term, the school will be having a 'Book Week'.

Science

In Science, we will be looking at light. Children will be investigating different light sources as well as investigating shadows and explaining how and why they are formed.



Geography

Rivers will be our lead topic this half term. Children will be looking at the features of a river and establishing why and how they are important to us. Our topic will include a trip to a local river in order to gain first hand experience of its features, how it is formed and what life lives in our rivers.

Art

In Art this half term, we will be making river animals from paper and paste. We will first explore the shape and form of our chosen animal, before using newspaper and paste to create our 3D animal sculptures.

PSHCE/P4C

In PSHCE, we will be focussing on the themes 'Good to be Me' and 'Looking after the Environment'. In P4C, we will be continuing to use a range of stimulus in order to promote discussions.

Music

Our Music lessons this half term will continue to focus on tuned percussion instruments and developing rhythmic patterns.

RE

Our RE for this half term will focus on the changing emotions of Holy Week as we prepare for Easter.
