

SUMMER 2 - NEAR AND FAR

Maths

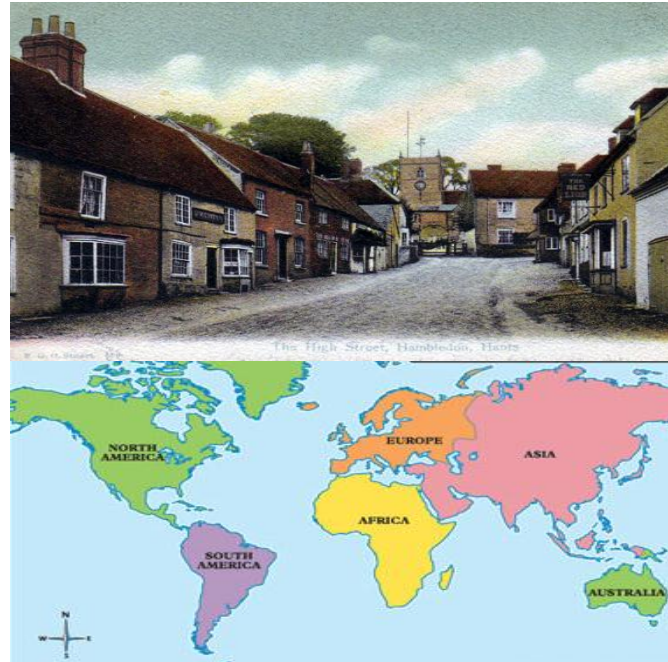
This half term in Maths, we will be covering a range of mathematical skills. For the first part of the half term, the children will be focussing on a variety of investigations. We will also be exploring measures, and will be revisiting weight and time. In addition, we will be looking at ways of collecting data and presenting this in a range of different ways.

Geography

Geography will be our lead subject this half term, as we explore the topic 'Near and Far'. The children will be focussing on Hambleton and its twinned village - Reville in Normandy. In order to celebrate the World Cup, we will also be exploring the participating countries.

Art

This half term, we will be taking part in a Hampshire Art project entitled 'Near and Far'. Using the mediums of printing, drawing and painting, the children will create work on this theme, focussing on Hambleton and its twinned village, Reville.



Music

Our Music lessons this half term will focus on the Ukulele. The children will be showcasing their skills in an end of term performance.

Literacy

We will begin this half term with a mini module on 'Super Sentences' where the children will focus on improving the quality of their sentence structure. Later in the half term, we will be exploring the form of poems including haikus and tankas. To link with our 'Near and Far' topic and 'Healthy Schools' week, we will be creating leaflets. We will also be learning and retelling a story for a Pie Corbett assembly.

DT

Later in the half term, we will be making a frame from wood. The children will be learning how to safely saw and join wood in order to create their design.

Science

This half term, our Science will link to our DT module. The children will be learning about different materials and selecting ones suitable for their frame.

PE

On Mondays, the children will be refining and developing their tennis skills with our coach.
