Literacy

In Literacy this week, we have used the research we completed for homework to write an information text on our chosen World Cup country. We had to include information about the location of our country and its flag, the language spoken as well as the traditional dishes of our country. We also had to remember to include the key features of information texts too!

Maths

In Maths this week, we have focussed on fractions. On Monday, we revised the terms 'numerator' and 'denominator'. We then looked at the flags of different countries and identified which fraction of the flag a certain colour of it was. For example, a third of the French flag is red.
