Details of coach parking facilities		If the school uses a coach for school trips the coach has to park in the village and the children walk down to the coach as the lane leading to school is too narrow. The school has minibuses which are parked on site.

Transportation Links	
Buses*	Hambledon is served by two bus services the First Bus D1 service to and from Waterlooville. This service runs every two hours but does not co-incide with school start and finish times and therefore is no a viable method of travel to school. The First bus 654 service to Havant, serves the students in the village that are travelling to South Downs 6th form college, so again the times do not work for travel to the primary school.
Rail*	The nearest train station is Rowlands Castle some 9 miles away, therefore, this is not a viable method of travel to school for the pupils however, could be used by a keen staff member who would be prepared to cycle the last part of the journey.
Roads*	The road which runs passed the school is a single track country lane, which comes up from the cnetre of the village and connects to a Broad which leads to the next village. There are no pavements on this road.
Walking Routes*	The main routes of walking to our school from the village centre is up the High Street and along Church Lane, which involves walking in the road as there are no pavements or you at the top of the High street you can walk through the church yard. There is also a good route across the field from Stewarts Green, across the church car park and grounds . There is also a public right of way country footpath which can be used that comes along the edge of the Vineyards and comes out at the school entrance.
